COVID Guidelines.

Dear Competitor

Thank you for entering our event in this COVID 19 time, we still have to run under government COVID guidelines, hopefully not for much longer

This of course means we must make a few changes. We are not open to the public.

If anyone in your household is showing any symptoms, high temperature, new cough or loss of sense of taste or smell, or has been in contact with anyone COVID 19 positive in the last 10 days, do not travel to the event but stay at home. Remember everyone traveling on a carriage must be from your bubble. So we ask you not to groom share. This means we will not be able to find you a groom.

On Arrival: The Government rules require us to have a list of everyone who attends the show, you should have put this information on your entry form, please email Zoe if it is now different and you have other people in your party. Please limit your party to the minimum you need to compete plus anyone willing to help as a steward. So, on arrival the stable manager will ask you to confirm the list of people in your party/lorry to check it matches the names that are on your entry form. Random horse Passports will be asked for so please have them at the ready.

Paper Work: You will need to print this out before you arrive along with your competition number, none will be given out on site. All this will be found on an event page on the BC website.

Course Walking: Adhere to social distancing guidelines and **DO NOT TOUCH THE OBSTACLES.**

All the time you are with us it is vital that you respect social distancing 2m please. When parking please leave at least 5m clear between you and neighbouring camps. You will find many sanitizer stations around the site please use regularly to avoid transmission via contaminated surfaces.

We have done all we think necessary to keep us all safe from this virus, however it is vital that everybody who comes on site plays their part. Acceptance of all the COVID precautions is a condition of entry any breach will be treated seriously and dependant on severity could result in the people involved being sent home without any refund.

Please bring a supply of sanitizer, disposable protective gloves and appropriate wipes with you. If you want to wear a face covering that is fine with us.

We ask that whenever possible you use your own toilet facilities if you do use the public toilets sanitize your hands before and after. There will be places to empty chemical toilets.

Event Information we aim to minimise traffic in the Event Office/Secretary. The stable manager is the Point for competitors to summon assistance i.e. Vet, Farrier etc.

All other event specific information will be available online via WhatsApp, the website (you will get the links soon) and on the two notice boards one to be located by the stable managers and the second near the club-house.

Public Address will be used as normal PA available for H&S announcements and all other aspects of the event in the lorry park, arenas and the obstacle field. Commentary will be provided as before.

Dogs strictly on leads at all times.

We will contact you again with more information before you arrive and during your time with us.
